



Native Seeds Guide

Planting:

- Choose a sunny spot and plant in spring or early fall.
- Clear and loosen soil surface.
- Mix sand (or other carrier) with seeds and broadcast evenly.
- Press gently into soil.
- Water well and keep moist until established.

Common Milkweed	
Light	Full sun, partial shade
Soil	Sand, loam, clay
Moisture	Dry to medium
Zones	3 - 8
Blooms	June, July, August
Color	Pink, lavender
Height	2' - 4'
Spacing	1'
Supports	Pollinators, butterflies, hummingbirds

Broad-leaved Purple Coneflower	
Light	Full sun, partial shade
Soil	Sand, loam, clay
Moisture	Dry to medium
Zones	4 - 9
Blooms	June - September
Color	Magenta, purple
Height	2' - 5'
Spacing	1' - 2'
Supports	Bees, butterflies, birds

Foxglove Beardtongue	
Light	Full sun to light shade
Soil	Sand, loam, clay
Moisture	Dry to medium
Zones	3 - 9
Blooms	April - July
Color	White
Height	3' - 5'
Spacing	1' - 2'
Supports	Pollinators, butterflies, hummingbirds

Black-eyed Susan	
Light	Full sun, partial shade
Soil	Sand, loam, clay
Moisture	Dry to medium
Zones	3 - 9
Blooms	July - September
Color	Yellow
Height	1' - 3'
Spacing	1' - 1.5'
Supports	Bees, butterflies, birds

Showy Goldenrod	
Light	Full sun to light shade
Soil	Sand, loam, poor
Moisture	Dry to medium
Zones	3 - 8
Blooms	September - November
Color	Yellow
Height	3' - 5'
Spacing	2' - 3'
Supports	Bees, butterflies, moths, other insects, birds
